Soil Delineation Sampling Investigation Report, prepared by Credere Associates, LLC, dated September 24, 2013 (Activity #201428)

Dear Ms. Fulweiler:

The New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services (DES) has reviewed the subject report and other information in our files regarding the petroleum discharge discovered on September 15, 1993 at the referenced site. The report meets the investigation and reporting requirements approved in the work scope authorization signed on August 1, 2013. Based on our review of the existing information, DES has the following comments:

1. DES concurs with the recommendation presented on page 7 to excavate the impacted soil in the vicinity of SB-100, SB-107, SB-108, SB-109, and SB-119 for transportation to an off-site facility for proper disposal. Soil results and boring log information provided for soil boring SB-120 indicates that soil excavation is not warranted in this area. Please submit a detailed work scope and budget for soil excavation for DES approval no later than March 1, 2014.
2. DES will request the installation of additional monitoring wells in a separate letter following completion of site remediation and redevelopment activities.

Facility Compliance and Cost Reimbursement

A review of our files shows that Town of Tilton is eligible to be reimbursed by the New Hampshire Petroleum Reimbursement Fund Program (Fund) for costs to implement DES-required investigation and remediation related to the petroleum discharge discovered on September 15, 1993.

To receive reimbursement from the Fund, all work must be pre-approved and conducted in accordance with the Oil Fund Disbursement Board *Guidance Manual: Policies, Procedures & Rules for Reimbursement*. Please direct your consultant to submit a detailed work scope and budget for DES approval. The work scope and budget is due within 30 days of receipt of this letter.
