## Winnipesaukee Transit System Announces Changes to the Operation of the Public Transit System Effective July 30, 2012

Winnipesaukee Transit System will be making the following route changes and adjusting the time schedule serving the towns of Belmont, Franklin, Gilford, Laconia and Tilton, New Hampshire.

Service will be expanded along the Route 3 corridor from Lakeport in Laconia out to the Kellers Shopping Plaza in Gilford. The bus stop will be at Kellers Shopping Plaza in Gilford.

There will be two additional bus stops added. One in the public parking lot behind 296 Main Street in Tilton and one on the corner of Memorial and Central Streets in Franklin.

Lakes Region Community College (LRCC) in Belmont will become a request stop. Customers will be able to travel to and from LRCC, by calling a day in advance to schedule the ride.

Belle Peabody Housing in Tilton will become a request stop. Customers will be able to travel to and from Belle Peabody Housing by calling a day in advance to schedule a ride.

## How the Service Works

Passengers may board or depart the bus at any of the scheduled stops along the planned route. Route Deviations: If you live within a 1/4 mile of the planned route you can arrange in advance to have the WTS bus pick you up by calling 528-2496 by 4 PM prior to the day of travel. When you schedule your ride, please state if the trip is one-way or round-trip.

Deviations are on a first come, first serve basis as the schedule permits. There is no charge for deviations. On-board requests are not permissible. Please be ready 10 minutes prior to scheduled pickup times as the bus cannot wait.

No flag stops or hailing from the street are allowed.

## Service Policies

### Passenger Policy

- Passengers 12 years old and under must travel with an accompanying adult.
- All children must remain seated for the duration of the bus ride and WTS encourages the use of available seat belts for all children.
- Child safety seats for infants must be provided and installed by the accompanying adult.

### Strollers and Collapsible Carts

- It is WTS's policy to require children to be removed from a stroller for the duration of the bus ride.
- Strollers and empty carts must be collapsed before boarding the bus, placed between seats, and not in an aisle.

### Shopping bags and Parcels

- WTS drivers may assist with the loading and unloading of bags or parcels, but will not carry them to your door.
- Passengers are not allowed to make multiple trips from the curb to the bus to load or unload bags or parcels. You must be able to safely carry all of your bags or parcels in one trip.
- Shopping bags or parcels must be stowed under the seat, on the floor in front of the seated passenger or on the passenger's lap. They cannot block or obstruct the aisle.

### General Rules

- No smoking, eating or drinking on the bus.
- Volume on radios and cell phones must be on low, on vibrate, or used with ear buds.
- Passengers are to remain seated until the bus comes to a complete stop. WTS encourages the use of available seat belts for all passengers.
- Mobility devices are required to be secured by the driver.
