



ALL ABOUT DOGS

To renew your dog(s) online go to www.tiltonnh.org . The Clerk's office will send you a reminder notice which includes a PIN#. The PIN# will be needed if you choose to renew online.

According to RSA 466:1-a and RSA 466:4 a current rabies vaccination and either a spaying or neutering certificate, if appropriate, will be required.

All dogs, four months old or over, living in the State of New Hampshire must be licensed by their owners in the town or city of residence. License a new adult dog immediately. License a puppy as soon as it is 4 months old and has had its rabies shot. The license period runs May 1st through April 30th of each year.

License renewals are generally available in February. Please call to see if licenses are available.

Per RSA, the Clerk shall annually between June 1st and June 20th, prepare a list of owners who have not renewed their licenses by May 31st. It is the owners' responsibility to register their dogs in a timely manner. A civil forfeiture for each unlicensed dog will be issued and the owner will be contacted by the Tilton Police Department. There will be a \$32 forfeiture fee along with the license fee and any monthly late fees.

The standard fees are as follows:

Male or Female	\$10.00
Neutered Male or Spayed Female	\$7.50
Senior (owner 65 or older) 1 st dog license	\$2.00
Puppy Fee	\$6.50
